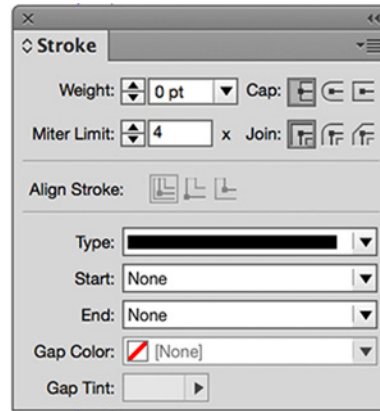
Four Key InDesign Palettes

Palettes appear under the Window menu, and when open, appear on the right side of the InDesign Window; many functions of the Control panels can be found in Palettes



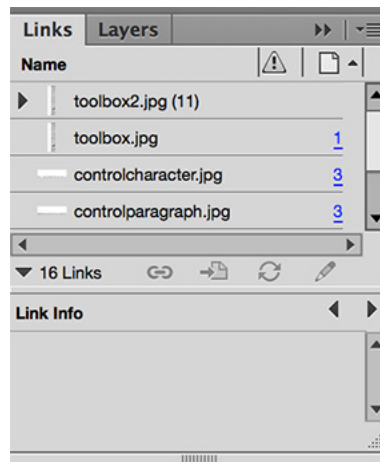
Pages

Use this palette to toggle between pages. You can also set a folio or other object to repeat, using the A-Master. Adding, deleting and rearranging pages can be done here.



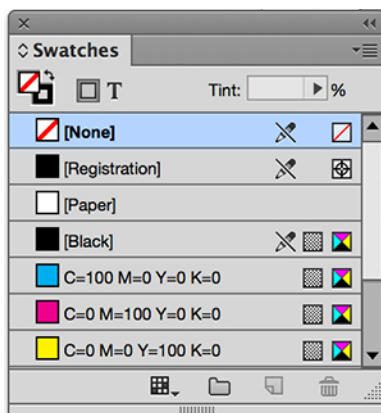
Stroke

You can set stroke (line) weight, align strokes, select types of strokes (dots, dashes, etc.) and add an arrow, circle or square to one or both ends of a stroke.



Links

Art placed on a page is linked to the page. This palette shows you if your links are present. If a stop sign appears beside a link, it means that link is missing. If a caution sign appears beside a link, it means that link needs to be updated. This palette helps you find links



Swatches

This palette lets you save colors you use often. The menu in the upper right also allows you to select colors from Pantone palettes as well as create a color. You can color both objects and text in this palette.

Shortcut Quick Reference
